IMPORTANT:

- **Eligibility:** All exhibitors must be on a DOCOF team to enter this event.
- **UDX Option:** You may enter for a UDX leg if desired – additional fee
- **DOCOF-Only Entries:** Entries for "DOCOF Only (Not Set)" will be placed in a Wild-Card class and will not earn legs.
- **Confirmation Info:** Final entry confirmations will display as "B," "Preferred Class," or "Wildcard Class" (for DOCOF-only entries).
- **Class Format:** All classes will utilize A pattern.
- **Score Submission:** If you earn a qualifying score of 170 or higher in your DOCOF class, it will be submitted to the AKC for leg/title credit, provided you have also entered the set. All awards will be presented after any and all runoffs have been completed.

Exhibitors who qualified may pick up their qualifying ribbon as they leave the ring. All Placements will be done at the end of the day.

ENTRY FOR DOCOF/SET Class.....\$35.00

ENTRY FOR UDX Class.....\$15.00

If a dog is entered in both DOCOF/SET/UDX Class , you MUST pay the fee for the FIRST ENTRY of the dog in DOCOF/SET Class and then add fee for UDX.

For example:

- A dog entered in DOCOF only fee is \$35.00 (same fee if adding set)
- A dog enters DOCOF/SET and UDX is \$50.00 (additional class of either open or utility)

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS:

CLOSING DATE for entries is Wednesday, July 15, 2026, 6 PM, after which time entries cannot be accepted, changed or cancelled except as allowed per move up clause below. Entries must be signed by owner or agent and submitted with fees.

No telephone or fax entries can be accepted. EXPRESS DELIVERY services must include SIGNATURE WAIVER permitting them to be left WITHOUT recipient's signature.

NOTE: Classes will run in Jump Height Order — Low to High

All entries must be legible and have a jump height if entered in classes that use jumps or it will be refused.

Note: Highest Scoring. Dog means either sex. In the case of tied scores between dogs eligible award, the dog completing, in the least amount of combined time will receive the award. In the event that both the score and time are the same, each dog will be tested again, individually, HC by performing an Excellent course and HTQ a Master as chosen by the judge. The original scores will not be changed, but a plus (+) will be added after the score of the dog winning the run-off. The judge for a run-off will be

designated by the club from among the judges of the Obedience trial.

AKC Recording Fees: Entry fees include a \$4.50 Obedience Event fee for each entry at every club licensed. These fees are collected by the show-giving club and remitted to the American Kennel Club. (New AKC Rule effective January 1, 2026)

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, unsafe weather conditions or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Transfers: No Transfers are allowed

VACCINATIONS ETC. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

BITCHES that come into season after the closing date for entries may have the entry fee less \$4.00 per dog per class refunded upon written request of the owner or handler before the start of judging on the day of the trial.

ATTENTION ALL EXHIBITORS

- Misconduct at hotels/motels may result in an Event Committee hearing.
- Exhibitors are responsible for picking up after their dogs at the DTCSP Training Building and at hotels/motels. Your continued responsibility and respect allow hotels / motels to continue to work with Dog Training Club of St. Petersburg, Inc. so we can provide you with the best venue possible. Please relieve your dogs in marked areas outside and be careful to not allow your dog to mark or urinate inside or on the buildings, trash cans and cars nearby. Trash cans are placed throughout the grounds-please use them.
- The Dog Training Club of St. Petersburg, Inc. Trial is located in a smoke-free building.
- Per AKC rules no dogs are allowed in the show rings for practice at any time.
- Please bring your own chairs and crates.
- Ex-pens are NOT permitted indoors at our trials due to building size limitations.
- No dogs may be left in the building after 6:00 pm or overnight.
- Jump Height is Low to High

KEN KINCAID

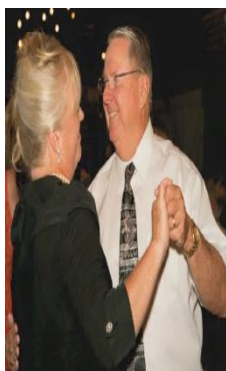
October 31, 1952 – April 26, 2026

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
4. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us).
